Foundation Studies

Overview

Foundation Studies has been designed for individuals who would benefit from learning and further developing the skills that will prepare them for further study in the college.

It is designed around Skills for Independence and Work and key skills development, and is suitable for individuals who may be considering further study in technical areas across the college.

English and maths is delivered to all individuals on the pathway through mixed delivery of discrete sessions and through embedded activities.

Some individuals on the pathway will also work towards an accredited English and Maths Functional skills qualification from Entry Level 1.

This pathway takes 1–2 years to complete.

What will be studied

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How will individuals be assessed?

Most individuals will undertake an accredited qualification in English and maths.

Some individuals may undertake an accredited qualification in Digital Skills and Personal Social Development.

Individuals will undertake progression pathways in different technical areas.

What can individuals do after?

Individuals may progress onto other supported programmes within Bloom. Others may move onto higher level qualifications at any of the college campuses.

Some individuals may wish to be supported out of education, for example, to access a social care provision or employment through a Supported Internship.
