# **One-to-One Support**

At every stage in their careers journey, we offer all of our students the chance to access personal careers guidance to plan their career and make their next steps. Students are able to access one of our professional and impartial advisers in either a personal guidance appointment, group setting or in a virtual setting.

Did you know that our service is completely **impartial**? This means that we can engage students in conversations about *all* of their options and tailor the support to suit them.

# **Going Digital**

Our service also supports our students from the comfort of their own homes! Students are able to access our suite of virtual resources, labour market information and video tools in order to help themselves go further in their own time.

### **Tailored Workshops**

We offer our students a tailored programme of careers workshops throughout the year. These cover a range of topics; from essential employability skills, to progression options workshops and support for entering the world of work. Our workshops help students develop the knowledge and practical skills needed to be successful after their course. These are both facilitated on campus and through virtual workshops.



#### **Careers Events**

Every year we host fairs and activities to start conversations with students about careers as part of our ongoing careers programme. In partnership with employers, training providers, internal college provision, higher education institutes, and other external providers, we run exciting events to showcase the range of opportunities available and prepare them for the demands of the world of work.
