# **Provider Access Statement**

# Introduction

This statement sets out the college's arrangements for managing the access of providers to students at the college for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the requirement for all students to have access to a range of opportunity providers in years 12 and 13 in order to plan their progression route/s.

## **Student entitlement**

All students are entitled:

- To find out about technical and vocational education qualifications and apprenticeship opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides impartial information on the full range of education and training options at each progression point;
- To hear from a range of local and national providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships through progression options events, tutorials and the careers programme;
- To understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

# Management of provider access requests

#### Procedure

An external events & visiting speakers risk assessment must be completed in advance of access to the college.
