



Adopting the IHRA's working definition of anti-semitism

The Sheffield College is pleased to have adopted the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance's (IHRA) working definition of anti-semitism following approval at our Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) Board in March 2022. EDI Board members felt that this move was in line with the college's Equality Scheme and our adopted values of Fairness, Respect, Equality, Diversity, Inclusion and Engagement or FREDIE values, which have been embedded across our organisation following extensive partnership working with the National Centre for Diversity.

Colleges and Universities have been encouraged to adopt this definition by the Secretary of State and, of note, the UK adopted this definition on 12th December 2016.
